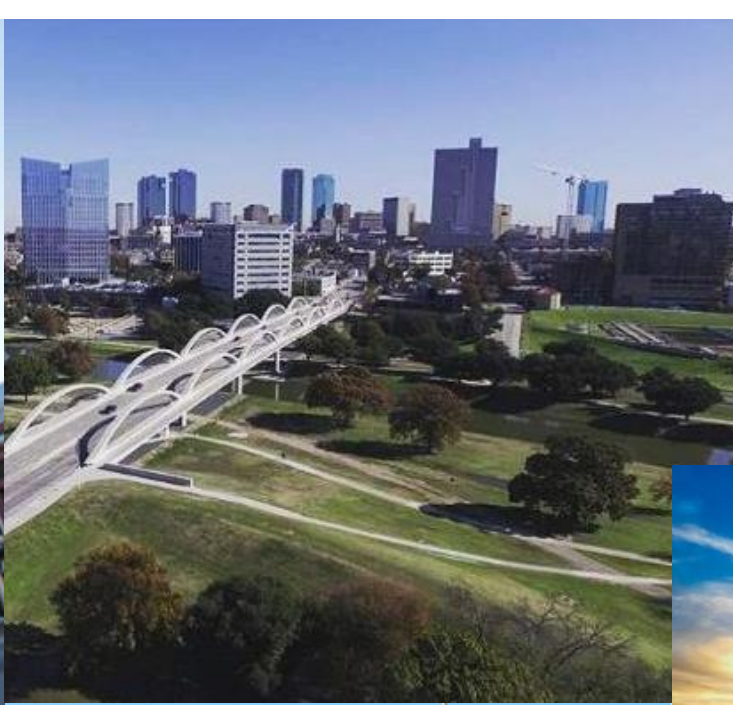

After his final night here on November 21, 1963, 35th President John F Kennedy and First Lady Jacqueline spent breakfast in the Crystal Ballroom, with President Kennedy making what would turn out to be his final address to 2,000 visitors.
